The Fifth International Laurence Sterne Foundation Conference Laurence Sterne's Words and Worlds Ca' Foscari University of Venice, Italy from 9 to 11 November, 2023





For the Conference the ILSF warmly welcomes proposals that focus on Sterne's interpretation(s) of the world through his language. Papers may consider Sterne's rhetorical, stylistic, narrative, formal strategies to refer to the world, his fictional approach to reality (be it historical, contemporary, social, cultural, religious, etc.), the relationship between narrative and truth in his works, the interplay between realism and imagination, his playing with words and their referentiality, the association between intertextuality and meaning, the gendered bias in his approach to world and word. 'Meta-critical' papers are also invited on the competing approaches to Sterne's interpretation, between philology and hermeneutics, historical reconstruction and philosophical deconstruction, authorial intentionality, and narrative indeterminacy. Each paper must be 15 to max. 20 minutes long.

Location

We will host the conference in the historical building of the Dogi Foscari family, since 1868 the main site of Ca' Foscari University (Dorsoduro 3246, Venezia).

The room we booked is located on the second floor and overlooks the Grand Canal where it bends between the Rialto and the Accademia bridges. The floor is served by lifts.

The conference will start at 3PM on November 9 and will end at 1PM on November 11.

Hotels and lodgings
